ALEXANDRA BARTH

b. 1989, Malacky, Slovakia Lives and works in Sanguinetto.

Alexandra Barth explores the potential of airbrush painting, which she uses for her attentive work with the light and textures of portrayed materials. Barth observes private spaces and details from the interiors of unknown homes through her minimalistic compositions and carved out reality. Through a curated selection of her own photographic prototypes, she pursues details of furniture or spaces during unfinished reconstructions, discovering dramatization of the everyday.

Barth is interested in the peculiar aspects of human activity, in the systematic arrangement of space, in the intimate aspects of the architecture of utility objects. The use of airbrushing allows her to work with the imprint of "photographic reality". By merging minimalism with a postmodern taste for fragmentation and the infra-ordinary, she opens the critical horizon of painting over painting.
